

120th IUVSTA Executive Council Meeting ECM-120 April 17 -19, 2015 Graz, Austria



Graz is the second-largest city in Austria after Vienna and the capital of the federal state of Styria and had a population of 309,323 (2012).

Graz has a long tradition as a student city: its six universities have more than 44,000 students. Its "Old Town" is one of the best-preserved city centers in Central Europe. In 1999, Graz was added to the UNESCO list of World Cultural Heritage Sites, and the site

was extended in 2010 by Eggenberg Castle. Graz was sole Cultural Capital of Europe for 2003 and got 2011 the title as UNESCO City of Design and is part of the Creative Cities network. <u>http://www.graztourismus.at/en</u>

The 120th Executive Council Meeting will be held in the hotel "Das Weitzer". <u>http://www.hotelweitzer.com</u>


This hotel is in the perfect location:

Arriving by car

Motorway A2 or A9, Graz-center exit. Follow the road s according map (see insert from © Google Maps.)

The best place to park your car is Citygarage belonging to the hotel for \in 14,- per day. Outside the hotel is a blue zone with a maximum stay of only 3 hours!



Arriving by plane

The airport shuttle service run by Grazer Verkehrsbetriebe (Business line bus 630) from the airport leads direct to the hotel "Das Weitzer". The outgoing shuttle stop at the hotel, incoming please get off at Griesplatz and go along Griesgasse to the hotel. Ticket price is ≤ 2.10 per person.

There are direct flights to Graz from Frankfurt (4 per day), Munich (4 per day), Vienna (4 per day) and Zurich (3 per day)

Arriving by train

Graz Hauptbahnhof (Central Station), then by taxi or tramline 1, 3, 6 or 7 to Südtiroler Platz/Kunsthaus. From there, turn right and go along the Mur, pass <u>Hotel Wiesler</u>, and it's about another 70 meters to the hotel "Das Weitzer". You can find train timetables at <u>www.oebb.at</u>

There are direct trains (Railjet) from Vienna (every hour, 2:35 h) and Praha (every 2 h)

Hotel booking and ECM-registration

The hotel must be booked directly by e-mail or phone in order to get the reduced room rate for the Executive Council Meeting. According to the agreement with Graz Universities the room rate per day is €95,- (€ 110,- double) including breakfast buffet and local tax.
